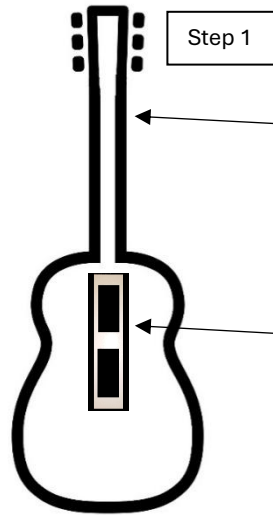




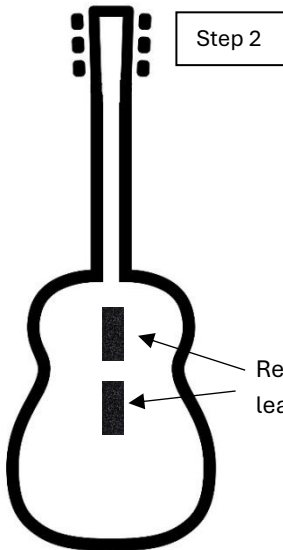

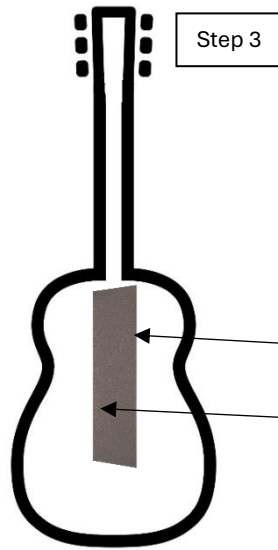
Neck

Place spacing template on back of guitar in line with the neck of the guitar. Peel the plastic backing off the provided velcro strips. Place velcro strips in the corresponding holes of the spacing template and onto the guitar.



Back

Remove spacing template leaving 2 velcro pads.



Back

Place Guitar wedge on guitar,

with the narrow part of the Wedge facing up toward your head.

**Important:**

1. Remove guitar wedge from the guitar before putting the guitar in its case.
2. When taking guitar wedge off of guitar be sure to grab it by the plaxiglass and not by the foam.
